About the University: Gurukula Kangri (Deemed to be University) was founded on March 4, 1902 by the martyr Swami Shraddhanandaji with the sole aim to revive the ancient Indian Gurukula System of education. This institution was established with the objective of providing an indigenous alternative to Lord Macaulay's education policy by imparting education in the areas of vedic literature, Indian philosophy, Indian culture, modern sciences and research. GKV has 24 departments under ten faculties of studies including Humanities, Science, Life Science, Technology, Engineering & Technology, Management Studies, Education, Medical Science & Health, Yoga and Physical Education. GKV was granted the status of 'Deemed to be University' in 1962. It is one of the three institutions in the country to be granted this status with 100% funding from UGC/Govt. Of India. GKV has a lush green 213.48 acers campus area. There are total three campuses; two (Main and FET campus, KGC Haridwar) are in Haridwar and one at Dehradun (KGC, Dehradun).

About the Department: The first course in Mathematics was started in GKV in 1958 at the undergraduate level while the post graduate classes were started in 1964. Later on in 1986 Vishwavidyalaya was allowed to offer Ph.D. program in the department. Since its initial stage the department is offering various reading courses in Mathematics at different levels and thus doing the continuous efforts of making the people aware of the recent as well as ancient knowledge of Mathematics. The increasing demand for specialized persons in different research and industrial establishments has led us to keep syllabi of different courses up to their standard. However, this is felt that this progress should not be at the cost of our ancient knowledge of mathematics.
