Sub: Manpower Training Programme in Computer Science
and Technology proposal for starting 3 year's
Master of Computer Application (MCA) Programme.

Sir,

With reference to your request for introduction of MCA Course,
I am directed to convey the approval of the UGC for starting the
PG Course of three years duration leading to the award of degree
of Master of Computer Application (MCA).

The financial assistance for the following items and upto the
limit indicated below will be provided for running the course.
This assistance would be made available by UGC for a period of
five years and thereafter, the entire recurring expenditure will
have to be taken over as committed expenditure by the University/
State Government:

1. Staff - 3 (1 Professor, 1 Reader and 1 Lecturer).
2. Rs.1.00 lakh p.a. for hiring guest faculty for teaching MCA
students. The use of guest faculty should not be less than
40% of total teaching.
3. No hardware will be sanctioned separately for MCA Course.

The students should be trained in the existing computer centre
and if the centre needs augmentation in terms of PCs or terminals,
proposal may be sent to UGC separately.

The payment of grant for the above purpose would be based on
actual expenditure each year for a period of five years only.

The details and the conditions applicable may be seen in the
revised scheme of UGC for the MCA.
