



#### **RUDRAKSHA** - our Ancient Heritage

Rudraksha is found in the mountains of HIMALAYA in Nepal. It is also found in Indonesia (Jakarta). Some of the trees of Rudraksha are present in HARIDWAR, other than this, they are also found in regions of Assam, Madhya Pradesh, Arunachal Pradesh. Rudraksha found in Nepal are in the shape of Amla. It is found very high up places in Nepal; the tree of Rudraksha is just like a mango tree; tall and very thick. Rudraksha in its shape is like circular berries, In Nepal it is found in Dhahran, Dhigla & Bhojpur. The peel of this is thrown away and the seed found inside is called Rudraksha. The Rudraksha that is found in Indonesia is small in shape; garland & rosaries can be made from it. There is a very thick line over Rudraksha which is called its 'MUKH' (face), generally, there are five lines (MUKH) over Rudraksha, in some the lines can be less than or more than five. ' Rudraksha ranges from one face to 21 faces. Generally Rudraksha are from two to fourteen faces. It absorbs the negative energy around the environment and provide positive wives to the wearer. It is

believed that by wearing Rudraksha people suffering from Blood pressure are relieved. It brings inner silence, peace & protection from untimely death. Rudraksha trees in Haridwar are present in Harihar Ashram (Kankhal), Shree Avdhoot Mandal Ashram, Shree Shree MA Anandamayi Ashram (Kankhal), Sureshwari

Devi Temple (Rajaji National Park), etc. and some trees of RUDRAKSHA are also present in Gurukul Kangri Vishwavidyalaya (Haridwar).

# Mountain region:-Economic Development Status of Uttarakhand

Uttarakhand is carved out from Uttar Pradesh in 2000 and no doubt it developed with rapid speed in comparision toother new separated States. The literacy rate of Uttarakhand is as high as 79.63% and Dehradun district is the biggest contributor to its literacy rate. It is also known as education hub of the state. State government focused on several economic issues like network connectivity, tourism development and entrepreneur subsidies for economic growth. Service sector of Uttarakhand is an important source of income of the state. Among these tourism sector is playing a vital role to generate income as well as employment. Employment status of Uttrakhand is improving year by yearboth inrural and urban areas but men employment rate is going down as compared to women employment rate in rural areas. Many researchers found the reason behind declined employment in rural areas is migration of male worker from rural to urban areas in search of better opportunity. The major beneficiary of GST would sectors like FMCG, Pharma, Automobiles and consur durables. High inflation impact would be on teleco banking and financial services, Air and road transp construction and development of real estate. Howe GST is a long-term strategy.
