


Certificate Courses Launched - 2020

Seed Funding in India

Prarambh' means 'an auspicious beginning'. As a verb, it implies 'to start'. Prarambh is expected to bring together top policy makers, industry, academia, investors, startups and all stakeholders from across the globe. In addition to deliberating on good practices from best of the ecosystems across the world, the sessions of the Summit are designed to showcase the spread and depth of entrepreneurship based on innovation in India. The idea is to attain the attention of global capital for startups in India, mobilize domestic capital, provide opportunities for accessing international markets to our startups and evolve enabling policy provisions.

What Is Seed Funding?

Seed funding or seed stage funding is a very early investment which aims at helping a business grow and generating its own capital. Also referred to as seed money or seed capital, investors often get equity stake in exchange for the capital invested. The investors can themselves be the founders and use their savings as seed money for their new company also known as bootstrapping.

Why Seed Funding Matters?

It is a fact that starting a new business and lifting it up off the ground is a huge ask for most entrepreneurs and it only gets tougher with capital constraints. Seed funding helps get things started before the business earns any revenue. It is an effective solution for startups and growing businesses as it provides the much-needed early monetary support.

How To Raise Seed Funding?

There are a few steps founders need to follow in order to understand how to

get seed funding for a startup. For the best investment in terms of amount and investor relations, founders and entrepreneurs need to research the investor market and find an investor that is active for the sector in which the startup is working. Startups should also be ready with all the paperwork and bank details that will be needed for the transaction. One of the most important parts of impressing the potential investor is the presentation. It should be precise with all the necessary data that the investor would want to know. The presentation should include all projected data and justifications for those projections. If the numbers seem impressive and achievable to the investors, they will proceed to the negotiations. This way, startups can raise seed money in India and overseas.

Going ahead, the government will provide guarantees to help startups raise debt-capital. The government will launch a Rs 1,000-crore seed fund for startups, called Startup India Seed Fund, which will help startups with the initial capital for growth and operations.

The new seed fund for startups comes after the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology had earlier last year initiated a similar fund to identify startups and give them financial help. In August, the ministry had launched a fund to identify 300 startups which would be provided seed fund of up to Rs 25 lakh and other facilities as well. A budget of Rs 95.03 crore has been earmarked for the programme named 'Chunauti', to be spent over a period of three years. The IT Ministry's programme seeks to award startups in the fields of edu-tech, agri-tech, supply chain, logistics, and transport management, as well as medical healthcare, diagnostics, preventive and psychological care among other areas.

Apart from these seed funds, the ministry has over the last year also conducted several other competitions to award startups working in several areas, such as video-conferencing, artificial intelligence among others. Last July, the ministry had launched a challenge inviting Indian developers to come up with apps in a range of segments such as office productivity, social networking, e-learning and news, games, health and wellness, agritech, fin-tech and entertainment, and speech translation, among others.

A different challenge launched in April last year, which sought a world class video-conference solution, which could be an alternative to global apps such as Zoom, saw Kerala-based Techgentsia Software Technologies win a prize money of Rs 1 crore.


