Qualifying marks in the entrance test shall be 50% (along with minimum marks in each section as prescribed in the rules and regulations for Ph.D.), provided that a relaxation of 5% of marks (from 50% to 45%) shall be allowed for candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC (Non-creamy layers)/ Differentlyabled category/Staffward of GK (DU) in the research entrance test conducted by the university. An interview/viva-voce shall be conducted wherein the candidates are required to discuss their research interest/area through a presentation before a duly constituted departmental research committee (DRC).
