









Event Report EUREKA-2025 Pitching Competition

Introduction

The Entrepreneurship Cell of our college successfully organized the EUREKA-2025 Pitching Competition, an initiative under the umbrella of IIT Bombay's Eureka! 2025. The competition aimed to foster entrepreneurship, provide exposure to early-stage startups, and connect aspiring entrepreneurs with mentors and evaluation opportunities. The event also served as a gateway for participants to secure a fast-tracked evaluation for Eureka's Zonal Round.

Day 1: 20th August 2025 - Orientation & Motivation

Venue: Old Seminar Hall, Faculty of Engineering & Technology, Gurukula Kangri (DU), Haridwar.

The event began with an introductory session, where students were made aware of EUREKA-2025 and the opportunities it offers.

The E-Cell team highlighted the importance of entrepreneurship and encouraged active participation from students across departments.

Details regarding the registration process, including the necessity of registering on both the college's event platform and the official Eureka! platform, were emphasized.

Day 2: 28th August 2025 – Final Pitching Round

Venue: Old Seminar Hall, Faculty of Engineering & Technology, Gurukula Kangri (DU),

Haridwar.

The Final Round of the pitching competition was held with enthusiastic participation from students representing diverse courses and early-stage startup ideas.

The event was inaugurated with encouraging opening remarks by the Honorable Dean of Faculty of Engineering and Technology, who applauded the E-Cell's initiative in nurturing entrepreneurial spirit.

Each shortlisted startup presented a 5-minute pitch, followed by a Q&A session with the jury.

The jury panel, along with witnessing faculty members, provided valuable feedback, constructive criticism, and improvement suggestions to participants, making the session highly insightful.
