

Report on the Signing of Letter of Intent (LOI) Between Magic Bus India Foundation and Gurukula Kangri University

Under ITC CSR Programme for Student Skill Development

Gurukula Kangri Deemed to be University, Haridwar, and Magic Bus India Foundation have formally signed a **Letter of Intent (LOI)** to initiate a collaborative training programme. This partnership has been established under the **ITC CSR-funded initiative**, aimed at providing specialized training in **Verbal Communication** and **Life Skills** to students from various faculties.
