Gurukula Kangri (Deemed to be University) was established in 1902 by the martyr Swami Shradhhanandji Maharaj. The University was established to provide an option of imparting education in the national language, discouraging English medium of education in India based on the western education policy of Lord Macaulay. It aimed at creating a viable environment for students for higher learning and research in the areas its inception, the Arya Samaj has been advocating women subject, since its inception, the Arya Samaj has been advocating women education. In order to shape this dream, the Kanya Gurukula Mahavidyalaya (K.G.M.) Dehradun was established in 1923 by Late Acharya Ramdevji Later the Kanya Gurukul Classes. The Basic task of the Vishwavidyalaya is to make them ideal citizens, by giving them education of ancient and modern subjects, without any discrimination of cast and creed and untouchability on the pattern of Gurukula system of education which emphasizes healthy and harmonious teacher - relationship. The Vishwavidyalaya is situated about 5 Km in south from Haridwar Railway Station.

Recognizing the objectives and services of the institution, Government of India, In June, 1962 conferred on it the status of "Deemed to be University" the under UGC Act. Of 1956 Article 3, for imparting education in Vedic literature, Sanskrit, Literature, Indian philosophy, Hindi Literature, English Literature, Psychology, Mathematics, and Ancient Indian History Culture & Archaeology, Zoology & Environmental Science, Engineering, Ayurvedigyan, Yogic Science, Management Studies, Physical Education, Pharmaceutical Science etc. have also been started. University has been accredited third time by **National Assessment & Accreditation Council (NAAC)**. Needless to say that all the degrees conferred by the University are recognized by Govt. of India/University Grants Commission.

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SCHEDULED CASTE/SCHEDULED TRIBE CELL

The Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes Cell (SC-ST Cell) of the Vishwavidyalaya aims to promote and protect the equality, dignity, human right and social justice for all with special attention on backward group of the Indian society within the Vishwavidyalaya. The Cell is committed to create a people centred and sustainable environment in the Vishwavidyalaya through monitoring and evaluating existing reservation policies along with suggesting measures to the Vishwavidyalaya for effective implementation of the reservation policies/ guidelines issued by take Government of India/University Grants Commission from time to time.

Highlight of some of the activities of SC-ST Cell (2025-26):

Following are the highlights of the activities/action performed during 2024-25 in which SC-ST Cell has provide its active input:

- **Dr. Jaspal Singh** is working as a liaison Officer of SC-ST Cell.
- The SC-ST Cell prepared category/gender/level-wise data base of the teaching and non-teaching staff of the Vishwavidyalaya and the same was sent to UGC, Ministry of Education, Govt of India and other agencies as per requirements.
- In the light of UGC guidelines issued time to time regarding backlog posts, the matter for filling up of the backlog posts lying in the Vishwavidyalaya was brought to the notice of the Advisory Committee of the SC-ST Cell. The Vishwavidyalaya administration took, The recruitment process.
- Due to combined efforts of the SC-ST Cell and various Dean Offices and other States of India were assisted and guided to get scholarship from social welfare Departments of their respective states/University Grants Commission etc.
- The application process for scholarship for the SC/ST/GEN students belonging to Uttar Pradesh was largely upgraded by the concerning Government, New guidelines/application form/affidavit formats/receipt format etc. were issued.
- The SC-ST Cell took utmost care for the implementation of prescribed reservation in admission and therefore on request of the SC-ST Cell, the Vishwavidyalaya appointed a representative belonging to the reserved category as a member of each admission committee, similarly, in recruitments. The representation of the member of reserved category in the Selection board was also ensured by the administration.
- Various Government agencies from time to time ask for the category wise information of the student studying on the Vishwavidyalaya who pass/fail in the examination. There for, the inclusion of category of the students along with other details in the examination gazette (result) was made necessary by the Advisory committee (SC-ST Cell) and Evaluation Department of the Vishwavidyalaya was informed accordingly.

PUBLIC RELATIONS SECTION

To Fulfil the objectives and goals of the University, the Public Relations Department is discharging its responsibilities with all its energy. The important work of effectively promoting every activity of the university, findings from research, various award-winning activities, sports and cultural programs are publicized and disseminated to the public by the Public Relations Department. The department maintains communication with media personnel and promotes the activities of the university. The Public Relations Department provides general information regarding the university sought by students or any other citizen.

Central Library

The Central Library of Gurukula Kangri (Deemed to be University), Haridwar, has been an integral part of the institution since its establishment in 1902 by Swami Shraddhanand Ji at Kangri village. Following the devastation caused by floods in Kangri, the library was relocated to its present building in 1926. At present, the library is under the supervision of Professor In-charge, Prof. Devendra Kumar Gupta, supported by Dr. Anil Kumar Dhiman as Information Scientist, Dr. Sachin Kumar Kaushik as Professional Assistant, along with three Semi-Professional Assistants and six Library Attendants/MTS, of which three are permanent staff members.

The Central Library houses approximately 1,67,296 books covering a wide range of disciplines, along with nearly 8,500 bound volumes of journals. Teachers, research scholars, and students at undergraduate and postgraduate levels utilize its resources throughout the academic year. In the session 2019–20, the Book Bank facility was introduced for Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe students. A dedicated section was created to serve visually impaired learners in the central library.

The library currently subscribes to around thirty-two national and international journals in print form for research purposes, in addition to eighteen journals on Arya literature. The Reference Section preserves rare books and manuscripts related to Indian knowledge and tradition, including literature, religion, philosophy, and culture. In the current session, a total of 2,296 books amounting to ₹11,45,982 were purchased, while 11 books were received through donations.

In the digital domain, 367 e-books are accessible on the University website. Through the INFLIBNET initiative based in Gandhinagar, Gujarat, more than 6,000 e-journals, along with bibliographic databases, are made available to users via e-consortium. Both e-books and e-journals are also provided with remote access facilities for registered library members. The University is an active member of Shodhganga, under which 400 theses have already been uploaded for public access. Furthermore, under the Shraddhanand Repository, nearly 3,100 rare and handwritten books are preserved in PDF format and made available on the University website.

Shraddhanand Vedic Research Institute Department Faculty of Oriental Studies

Gurukula Kangri Deemed University, Haridwar was established in 1902 in Kangri Par, Haridwar. Even before its establishment, the university's founder, Mahatma Munshiram, had established a research department in Lahore in 1894 to propagate, disseminate, publish, and research the principles of Arya Samaj, the Vedas, and Maharshi Dayanand Saraswati in India and abroad. Initially, Mahatma Munshiram himself nurtured this department through writing and other means. Eighteen years after the establishment of Gurukula Kangri University, in 1920, this department was transferred to the university. This department received guidance from great scholars, preachers, writers, and dedicated workers of the Arya Samaj, such as Acharya Ramdev, Pt. Indra Vidyavachaspati, Pt. Bhagavadatta, Acharya Priyavrat Vedavachaspati, Acharya Ramnath Vedalankar, and Acharya Ramprasad Vedalankar. In 1991, this department was named the Vedic Research Institute, and Prof. Bharat Bhushan Vidyalkar was appointed to the post of Professor, under whose supervision the department continued to progress. In 1994, Dr. Mahavir Agarwal was appointed to the post of Reader in this department from the Sanskrit Department of the university, but he returned to his previous position before the year was over. Similarly, Prof. Bharat Bhushan Vedalankar also returned to the Vedic Department.

On March 2002, this department was named 'Shraddhanand Vedic Research Institute Department' after the university's founder, Swami Shraddhanand Maharaj, and through the efforts of the then Vice-Chancellor of the university, Prof. Swatantra Kumar, Prof. Gyan Prakash Shastri was appointed as Professor and Prof. Satyadev Nigmalankar as Reader, as per the advertisement. Due to their shared interest in and dedication to research, both scholars had the opportunity to write and publish voluminous, concise, socially relevant, and research-oriented books, which not only enhanced the department's reputation but also earned them respect from the NAAC team that visited the university. Since 2003, Professor Gyanprakash Shastri of the department has been publishing a research journal called 'Gurukul-Shodh-Bharati,' which has been continuously active. Currently, its editor is Professor Satyadev Nigmalankar, and the latest issue of the journal is in press. Professor Gyanprakash Shastri authored and edited numerous books. He has now retired, but the department will forever be indebted to his personality and contributions. Even now, whenever the department needs him, he readily comes forward. He has been succeeded in the professorial position by Professor Ram Prakash Varni. He remains actively engaged in research and continuously contemplates the advancement of the department while also writing books. Professor Satyadev Nigmalankar is a scholar of the Vedas and propagates the principles of Arya Samaj and Maharshi Dayanand Saraswati through his writings and speeches, and he also works diligently in the service of humanity. Many research scholars have completed their research work in the department, and currently, several research

scholars are pursuing their research here. The departmental faculty members also teach postgraduate classes in the Sanskrit Department, the Department of Astrology and Vedic Rituals, and the Department of Physical Education.

1. General Introduction of the Department –

Since the establishment of Gurukula Kangri University by Swami Shraddhanand (March 2, 1902), the Veda Department had arranged for independent study and teaching of Vedic texts. Its first teacher was Pundit Shivshankar Sharma Kavyateerth, a disciple of Pundit Ambikadatt Vyas, the world-renowned historical novelist of Sanskrit, who authored many important works such as 'Vedic History Arth Nirnay' among others. Other internationally known Vedic scholars have also taught in this department, including Pundit Nardev Shastri Vedateerth, Pundit Vishwanath Vidhallankar, Chandramani Vidhallankar, Bhagavadatt Vedalankar, Pundit Dharmadev Vidhamartand, Pundit Priyavrat Vedvachaspati, Pundit Ramprasad Vedalankar, Dr. Satyavrat Rajesh, Dr. Bharatbhushan Vidhallankar, Swami Brahamuni, and others. Even after receiving the status of a deemed university in 1963, this department remains significant. It is the only department in the entire world where the Vedas are taught and studied completely according to the beliefs of Swami Dayanand Saraswati, which does not happen anywhere else. While conducting research in the department, it is kept in mind what the current relevance and contemporaneity of Vedic knowledge are. The study, teaching, and research of the Vedas are carried out by connecting students with modernity. Special attention is given to the meanings of the Vedas.

Under the Department of Lifelong Education, Prof. Brahmadev, Dean, Faculty of Education and Training, various programmes are organised from time to time to train the teachers and staff under the guidance of the Dean. As per the instructions given by the Government of India and the University Grants Commission, the Faculty organises various training programmes and lecture series by subject experts from time to time to guide the teachers and staff, which benefits the University, teachers, staff and students in the field of education and research. Swami Shraddhanand Health Centre

The Swami Shraddhanand Health Centre, operated on campus by Gurukul Kangri Deemed University, was established on September 1, 2021. Since then, the health centre has been continuously providing medical services under the guidance of Dr. Navneet and Dr. Mukesh Kumar, and the able leadership of Dr. Sameer Srivastava. The health centre provides emergency medical services and also operates a physiotherapy centre, where physiotherapy services are provided by Mr. Daljit Singh to those visiting the centre. Throughout the year, the process of thoroughly examining and verifying the actual medical bills of permanent teaching and non-teaching staff of the university and their dependents, including bills for medicines, tests, and other medical expenses, as per the advice of the concerned medical professionals, has been carried out to prevent any future audit objections.

During the Gurukul-Vedic and Arya Samaj-related programs organized by Gurukul Kangri Deemed University throughout the year, the health centre sets up a health check-up stall where the health of guests, staff, and all students attending the programs is examined. The health centre contributed to the successful organization of the tribute ceremony on the 100th martyrdom anniversary of Amarhutatma Swami Shraddhanand by providing medical facilities and distributing free medicines. In the academic year 2025-26, approximately 2591 people received medical services from the department.

From time to time, the Swami Shraddhanand Health Centre organized medical camps in various departments of the university for the health check-up of university employees. During these camps, the health of the departmental employees was examined, and Dr. Sameer Srivastava provided appropriate advice regarding any medical problems detected during the check-ups.
