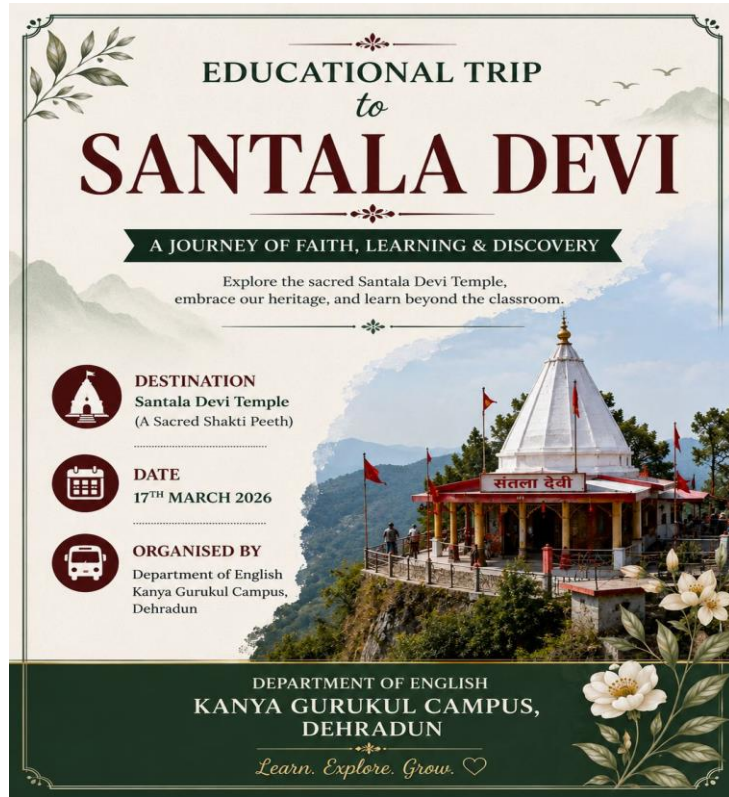


Report on Educational Trip to Santala Devi, Dehradun
